Dear Dr. Grove,

Several years ago Sublette County School District No. 9 was receiving a greater share of revenue from the county than Sublette County School District No. 1. At the time both school boards agreed to form a District Boundary Board. The Boundary Board redefined the district boundaries so both districts would receive a more equal amount of funding from the county.

A similar situation has developed at the present time, only Sublette County School District No. 1 is receiving a larger amount of revenue from the county than Sublette County School District No. 9. The Sublette No. 9 Board of Trustees believes it is time again to create another Boundary Board to equalize the wealth between the two school districts. This is not only important because of the revenue received from the county for educating the students, it is also important to have a more equal assessed evaluation so each mill approved by both boards would generate a similar amount.

The Sublette No. 9 Board of Trustees wants to know if the Sublette No. 1 Board of Trustees would approve the establishment of a District Boundary Board to once again redefine the present boundaries of each school district so the revenue from the county would be more evenly divided.

I am looking forward to hearing from you once you have had time to confer with your Board of Trustees. Thanks for your consideration of this request.
