**ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT
FOR DECLARATORY JUDGMENT**


The Plaintiffs have filed an action for declaratory relief seeking to have the Sublette County Clerk's declaration that a vote of the citizens of Sublette County reducing the number of commissioners from five (5) members to three (3) be declared invalid. The Plaintiffs ask that Defendant be ordered to issue a proclamation that there be two (2) additional county commissioner offices to be filled at the conclusion of the 2012 general election with a total of three (3) vacancies to be filled in the upcoming election.

The Defendant contends that she was complying with W.S. §18-3-501(a) and the latest vote of the citizens of Sublette County when it reduced the number of commissioners in a special election held on May 8, 2012.

Finding and concluding that the Clerk has acted in accordance with the requirements of W.S. §18-3-501, the relief requested by the Plaintiffs is denied and their Complaint dismissed.
