

On April 25, 2010, we held an emergency open meeting in accordance with Wyoming Statute 16-4-404(d). At the meeting a motion was made and seconded to meet in an executive session regarding a personnel issue which is confidential and not open to the public in accordance with 16-4-405(a)(ii). At that meeting we determined that it was appropriate to officially request that the county attorney investigate this matter.

All actions taken at an emergency meeting are temporary in nature. In order for actions taken at an emergency meeting to become permanent, they must be reconsidered and action taken at an open public meeting within 48 hours.

Today we met to reconsider our decision. After discussing the matter and meeting with our attorney, we learned that the County Attorney could not investigate the matter due to a conflict of interest. The county attorney has contacted an outside agency to conduct the investigation. At the conclusion of the investigation the results will be turned over to a special prosecutor to determine if any action should be taken. No further official action by this board is warranted.
