COMES NOW, Paul Alan Rock and Ernest W. Kawa, Petitioners herein, by and through Michael J. Crosson of Crosson Law Office P.C., and in support of this Petition allege as follows:

- 1. Petitioners are bona fide residents of Sublette County,
 Wyoming, and are qualified registered members of the Sublette
 County electorate, and were at all times pertinent hereto.
 Petitioners are aggrieved persons by virtue of Respondent
 implementing an illegal election to decrease the membership of
 the Sublette County Board of Commissioners in May 2012.
 Respondents are further aggrieved due to Respondent's failure
 to render a proclamation that two (2) additional commissioners
 shall be elected in the scheduled 2012 general election.
- 2. Respondent is the duly elected County Clerk in the aforementioned county and state, and was at all times

- pertinent hereto, and is statutorily charged with the duty of lawfully implementing elections in Sublette County.
- 3. On or about August 16th 2011, the electorate of Sublette County voted to increase the Sublette County Board of Commissioners from three (3) members to five (5) members, the election having been in compliance with all applicable laws including but not limited to Wyoming Statute \$18-3-501, the official results of which are attached as exhibit one (1).
- 4. On or about May 8th 2012, Respondent in her official capacity conducted an election not in compliance with Wyoming Statute \$18-3-501 or other applicable law, upon conclusion of which the electorate voted to decrease the Board of Sublette County Commissioners from five to three offices. The official results are attached as exhibit two (2).
- 5. Respondent lacked legal authority to hold the election May 8th 2012, purportedly negating the prior election conducted August 16th 2011, and said election results should be set aside and deemed null and void.
- 6. Wyoming Statute \$18-3-501 is the primary legal authority controlling an increase or decrease in the membership of Board of County Commissioners in the State of Wyoming.
- 7. Wyoming Statute \$18-3-501(f) provides in pertinent part,

 "Any county may decrease the *membership* (emphasis added) of

 its board of county commissioners from five (5) to three (3)

 members in the same manner as an increase under subsection (b)

- and (c) of this section." There is presently no membership to decrease, only vacant commission offices.
- 8. Wyoming Statute \$18-3-501(b) states in pertinent part,

 "Additional offices created under this subsection in oddnumbered years **shall** (emphasis added) be filled in the general
 election next following the election at which the increase was
 approved."
- 9. The unambiguous wording of the foregoing statute mandates that the offices created upon conclusion of the election held August 16th 2011 shall be filled at the general election to be held in 2012, and that any subsequent election to decrease the board can only take place after an election seating additional members has taken place, after the 2012 general election.
- 10. Respondent in her official capacity has issued a public record entitled "Primary Election Proclamation" which provides that the electorate of Sublette County will vote for only one (1) county commissioner during the general election to be held in November 2012. A copy of the proclamation is attached hereto as exhibit three (3), evidencing Respondent's intent to preclude the electorate from seating two (2) additional commissioners in the 2012 general election, in contravention of her lawful duties as Sublette County Clerk.
- 11. Petitioners are aggrieved persons entitled to review of agency action by the District Court, who hereby assert the

election held May 8th 2012 was illegal, and/or that two (2) additional offices must be placed on the ballot for the upcoming general election. By facilitating and implementing the May 8th 2012 election, and by failing to issue a proclamation that additional commissioners will be seated, Respondent acted in excess of statutory jurisdiction and authority without right, abused her discretion, acted not in accordance with law, and without observance of procedure required by law.

- 12. The Court has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Wyoming Statute \$16-3-114 and W.R.A.P. 12.01, and has personal jurisdiction over the parties, and venue is proper. All pertinent facts and conduct arise in Sublette County.
- 13. Petitioners affirmatively file this Petition under Wyoming Statute \$16-3-114.

WHEREFORE, Petitioners prays for the following relief:

- 1. That the May 8^{th} 2012 election be held unlawful and set aside and deemed null and void.
- 2. That Respondent be ordered to immediately issue a proclamation indicating that three (3) Sublette County Commission offices shall be placed on the ballot and filled upon conclusion of the 2012 general election.
- 3. For such other and further relief as the Court deems just.





CAMPAIGN FILING REQUIREMENTS



EVERY candidate, whether successful or not, must file a <u>Statement of Receipts and Expenditures</u> by August 31, 2012. A candidate must file the statement as required by law before receiving a certificate of election.

Every <u>Candidate's Campaign Committee</u> and <u>Political Action</u> <u>Committee</u> shall file a <u>Statement of Campaign Receipts and Expenditures</u> by August 31, 2012.

If you require assistance to vote by reason of blindness, disability, or inability to write, you may be given assistance by a person of your choice. If you have questions regarding the accessibility of your polling place, please contact your County Clerk.

Any person who expects to be absent from his place of residence on Election Day, or who cannot be present at his precinct polling place on Election Day because of illness, injury, disability, old age or tenets of his religion, may apply for an absentee ballot in person, in writing, or by telephone, at the Office of the County Clerk, Sublette County Courthouse, P.O. Box 250, Pinedale, WY 82941, 367-4372, 276-3827, or maryl@sublettewyo.com. Absentee ballots may be requested through August 20, 2012, at your County Clerk's Office.
