Options and Lewis Class explained

- for our less veteran shooters -


Options are an organized system of betting, where you may wager on your skill (or luck). For example, our station options are a \$2 per station bet (\$24 total - you buy the whole course) that you will shoot one or more stations as well as any other shooter in your class. If there are 10 shooters in your class, there is \$20 paid to the high gun at that station.

Lewis options are a fun game of chance which depends on the lineup of scores. After the shoot, all purse scores are arranged from top to bottom, and the lineup is segregated into a predetermined number of divisions, following specified rules governing ties. Moneys are paid to top scores within each division. Thus shooters have a roughly equal chance of coming out "in the money", regardless of their skill level, or performance on the day.
