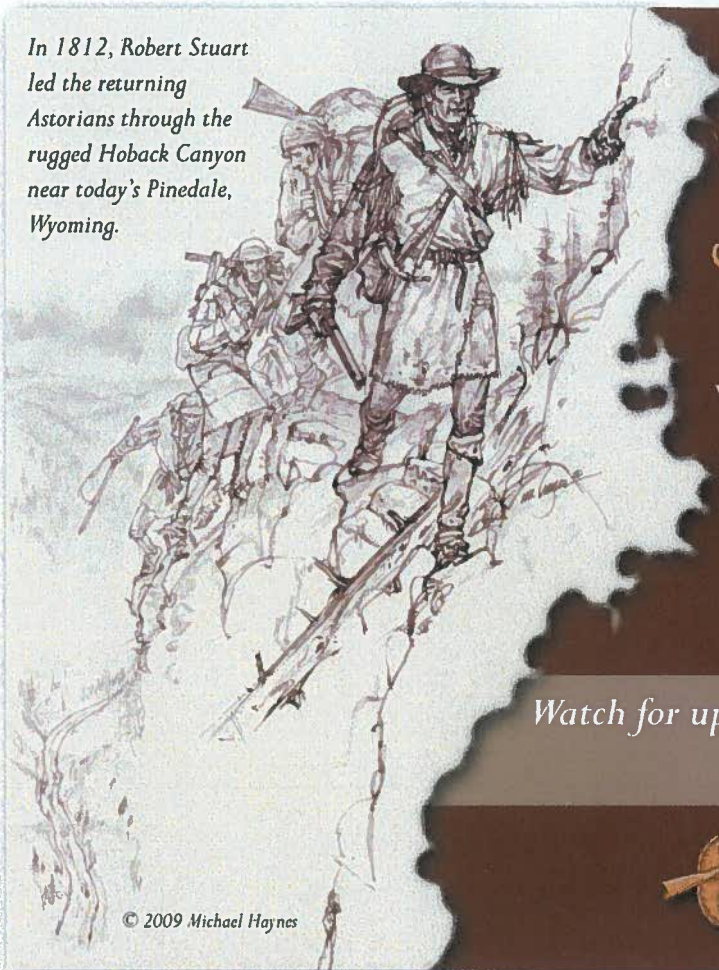


In 1812, Robert Stuart led the returning Astorians through the rugged Hoback Canyon near today's Pinedale, Wyoming.

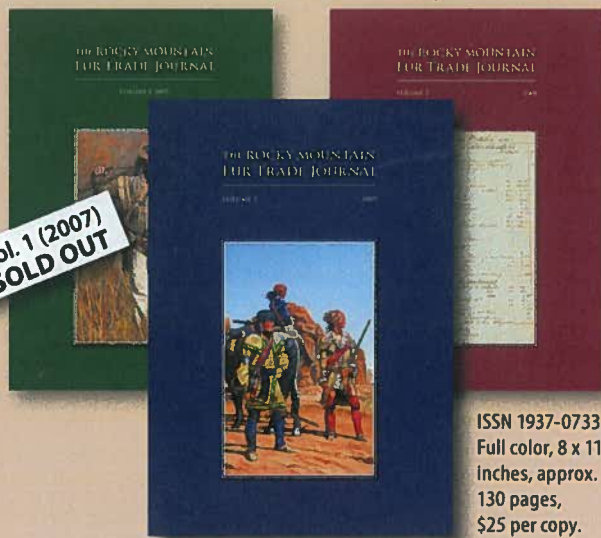
The *Journal* encourages research and debate in an academic arena. New perspectives and innovative topics are explored and previously accepted theories challenged in a defensible manner.
